



### **Class 1/ Novice Team Chase( BOGEY TIME)**

Entry Fee- £100 Per team

Prizes in Kind to 3<sup>rd</sup> place, rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Course; Approximately 2500m with approximately 25 fences combining the more inviting fences from the open team chase course with portables. Includes a holding pen. Maximum height 85cm  
Winners will be judged against an optimum time as set by the organisers.

### **Class 2/ Novice Team Chase (fastest time)**

Entry fee- £100 Per team

Prizes in Kind to 3<sup>rd</sup> place, rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Course to be the same as class one

Winners will be the team with the fastest time across the course

### **Class 3/ Open Team chase (fastest time)**

Entry Fee- £100 Per team

Prizes in Kind to 3<sup>rd</sup> place and Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> Place.

Course; approximately 2500m with approximately 25 fences with a maximum height of 1m10. Fixed and portable fences and includes a holding pen.

Winners will be the team with the fastest time across the course.

## General

- 1/Entries can only be accepted if they are submitted with the correct entry fee
- 2/Unless fees are received in full competitors will not be allowed to take part
- 3/Any competitor jumping a fence (other than the practice fence) prior to the competition will be disqualified
- 4/The organisers reserve the right to return or refuse any entry.
- 5/The organisers and the landowners do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators, or any person or property whatever on the ground. All vehicles are parked at the owners risk. No responsibility can be accepted for damage to or loss from those vehicles moving or parking on the premises.
- 6/ All Competitors must wear crash helmets to current recognised British or European safety standards and BETA approved level 3 body protectors manufactured in the year 2000 or after. All persons mounted (including grooms and helpers) must wear a hard hat.
- 7/Dogs must be kept on leads at all times
- 8/ No horse may compete in more than once.
- 9/Bibs should be collected from the secretary's box. A refundable deposit of £20 per team will be required.
- 10/Competitors will report to the collecting ring steward 15 minutes before their start time
- 11/Exchanging horses is not allowed after a competitor has started.
- 12/ The organisers reserve the right to :alter the advertised times, eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules.
- 13/In the event of a dispute the stewards decision is final
- 14/All fences must be jumped between the numbered flags and in the correct order.
- 15/Falls and refusals will be penalised by time only.
- 16/ Teams not completing the course inside the time limit will be eliminated.
- 17/Failure to jump all the fences in the correct order will result in that team member being eliminated and they must retire
- 18/ If competitors are ask to leave the course by an official they must do so immediately.
